



PROTECTION!

You have the right to be protected from bullying and harassment. Schools are required to take action against bullying. You don't have to convince schools that preventing discrimination is the "nice thing to do"- It's simply the law.

RESTROOMS!

You have the right to use restrooms, locker rooms, & other facilities that align with your gender identity, and can't be forced to use separate spaces from those of your peers.



SPORTS!

You have the right to participate in school activities, including sports teams, that align with your gender identity.

TRANS STUDENTS: KNOW YOUR RIGHTS AT SCHOOL

Minnesota schools have a legal obligation to treat ALL students with respect in an inclusive environment. When getting ready for school, make sure you know the rights you bring with you!

CLOTHES!

You have the right to wear the clothing permitted by the dress code that best aligns with your gender expression.

FORMING CLUBS!

If your school lets students form organizations, they have to allow all student organizations to form (including organizations like gender-sexuality alliances).The requirements must be the same for all groups and the same resources must be available to all groups.
